Long time TC Member Ralph Raimondi Passes Away

Veteran TC Member Ralph Raimondi passed away April 1, 2016 in Chino Valley, AZ. He was 70.

Born and raised in Portland, his life-long interest in all things automotive, and especially racing, began at about 8 years old, when a neighbor took him to the Rose Festival's Grand Prix at PIR. He had his first car before he had a license to drive it, and following that, well over a hundred different vehicles. His first new car, a 1972 Ford Capri (British Racing Green) began his Conference racing career. Ralph joined TC in 1974 because of its focus on Drivers as Members. He began and completed his novice program in 1975. In 1976 Ralph took ICSCC B-Sedan Championship with a very competitive field of 20 cars. Over the years, he was licensed by ICSCC, SCCA, and NASCAR and was a Driver Trainer for TC every year. Ralph was successful in just about anything he drove, including Formula Ford, Improved Sedans, TC's Continental, Endurance Racing, and finally a fun run in Winston West's Modified division at Portland Speedway in 1992.

Serving in several different offices of Team Continental, in 1979 Ralph was elected President of TC, Vice President in 1980, and Membership Chairman when TC put on its first Conference-sanctioned event at Olympia in 1986 with NWR.

Ralph and his wife Lida relocated to Portola Valley, CA in 1989 to care for their elderly families. He remained close to TC through his 40 year friendship with Rob Rissberger and Ann Curtis. He will be dearly missed by Lida, his wife of 38 years, his Oregon, California and Arizona families, many grand and several great grandchildren.
