TRACK TIME TRIALS - OVERVIEW

Track Time Trials are on-track events in which participants vie for the fastest lap or elapsed time to complete a designated course. Track Time Trials participants may share track, but these events are not wheel-to-wheel competitions.

TEAM CONTINENTAL CAR CLUB – PURPOSE

The Team Continental, Inc. (TC) is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization incorporated in the state of Oregon, dedicated to promote interest and enthusiasm in automobile road racing and associated events. To promote improvement in driving techniques and safety among members and others where possible. To lend assistance when possible to the motoring public.

VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY - OVERVIEW

For the most part, Track Time Trials are open to most four-wheeled vehicles that pass safety inspection. Bring your street legal or race prepared car – Just make sure it has good brakes and tires. Lap times are provided for those with a transponder, but official timing is not required to participate.





DRIVER ELIGIBILITY

- Competition license is not required no physicals, no mandatory club membership
- Minimum 18 years of age with a valid state or provincial driver's license
- The only thing you need is a Snell approved helmet (motorsports SA-rated preferred)
- Novice groups may incorporate limited point-by and could offer lead control car for training
- Advanced groups for the seasoned track day enthusiasts may feature passing anywhere

USER FRIENDLY PRICING

- Cost is \$175 for four (20 minute) sessions only \$2.18 per minute of on track experience!
- All entrants 30 yrs of age or younger will receive a complimentary 2019 TC Club membership
- Transponder rental cost for timing is \$25 (optional), mandatory to be eligible for awards
- Those eligible for awards will receive a personalized certificate to commemorate the event

- Saturday, August 3rd, 2019 with on track sessions running from 9am to 6pm
- This event is at Oregon Raceway Park (ORP) in Grass Valley using the South Loop course


