#### ANNOUNCING AN OPEN PRACTICE DAY:

Friday, July 23<sup>rd</sup> - Prior to the Lemons Race.

Event is open to all teams as well as individual Drivers, and O.R.P. Club Members. Advance registration is required. Sign up is now open through the O.R.P. Office: Brenda @ 541-333-2452

#### **Event Schedule & Supplemental Rules**

Thursday: 10:00 a.m. To 7:00 p.m. Gates open for move in and set-up. The Gate Holding Lot, East of the Security Building is open for late night arrivals.

Friday: 7:00 a.m. Gates open to STAR Practice Event registered vehicles only. As a courtesy, teams registered for the Saturday / Sunday events are welcome for move in after 10:00 a.m.

8:30 a.m. Mandatory drivers meeting will be followed by a mechanized track walk. (To save time we recommend that you bring a vehicle capable of carrying your whole team to the pregrid prior to the drivers meeting).

9:30 a.m. Driver wrist bands issued /open track practice begins.

12:00 Noon: Track is cold for lunch.

1:00 p.m. Track is green for open practice

5:00 p.m. Track is cold. No consumption of alcohol by anyone until the close for the day.

All O.R.P. rules will be enforced and are available on the O.R.P. website. You and your teammates are responsible to review them prior to your arrival. Overnight camping is encouraged and is free; however, the \$5.00 per person, per day maintenance fee applies and will be collected at the gate.

To minimize impact on racers setting up pits and paddock for the weekend endurance event, those attending Friday only (not part of a racing team) are requested to park in designated areas.

#### Supplemental Rules and Advice:

O.R.P. is at 2,350 feet. Temperatures at night can be cool. Wind can become fierce. Be prepared. Do not secure tarps and canopies to fuel jugs.

No fires are allowed. Keep a fire extinguisher in plain view while fueling.

Any time a vehicle is occupied by more than one person, one of those in the car must be on the O.R.P. recognized instructor list. Both parties must have signed the Dual Occupancy Release document.

92 Clear (non ethanol fuel) is available at the track pumps @ \$5.50 gal.

If you are operating a vehicle that is not equipped with seat belts (bicycle, power board, scooter etc.) you must wear a helmet while in motion.

No children allowed on the above vehicles at any time until the track is closed for the day.

Come prepared, civilization is a long way off.

No electrical plug-in without prior arrangement. A limited number of electrical permits are available through the track office.

Damages to track property (cones, break markers etc.) will be billed to the driver / team responsible.

Help us preserve the track's reputation for good citizenship in Sherman County; Please observe the posted speed limits.

#### Fees and such:

All pricing below assumes a completed registration with payment information not later than 15 days prior to the event. Your credit card information is needs to hold your spot. All fees increase by 20% after that time and 30% on day prior to the event (if space is available). No part day or mid-event registration will be accepted once the drivers meeting has commenced. Driver / Team cancelation: No refunds will be issued, however if requested not later than 5 days prior to the event, a 90% book credit will be issued transferable to a future Star Projects Event.

The daily gate fees may be paid in advance with advance registration. Annual passes will be honored.

One car one driver \$245.00.

Extra drivers same car \$175.00 each.

Team Entry: Up to four drivers one car \$450.00

Additional team drivers \$100.00 each.

All entries include our famous track lunch. Extra meals are available by advance arrangement at \$12.50 ea.

Private Instructor (team or individual) \$200.00 per day (advance arrangement required).

Is your team attending the Lemon's <u>and</u> Lucky Dog events? Sign up for both STAR Practice Days at the same time and receive a 10 % discount.

Those that do not attend the driver meeting will not be allowed on course until they have met with and been approved by the event organizer.

Not ready to run a race yet, but would like to try the team concept in a practice? Rental cars available @ \$600 per day wet. Porsches available at \$800. Damage cap maxed @ \$3,500.
