

Driver of the Year Award

The Driver of the Year Award was created in 2004. In order to be eligible for the Team Continental Driver of the Year award you must win a ICSCC or SCCA regional, divisional or national championship in that year and be a member of Team Continental. The selection procedure is as follows: The list of ICSCC or SCCA champions that raced under the Team Continental banner will be distributed with the board member election ballots. The membership will then select the Driver of the Year and the results will be announced at the annual banquet. The Driver of the Year trophy shall be the first trophy of rank listed in the perpetual trophy order per the By-Laws. If no driver from TC wins a Conference/SCCA regional, divisional or national championship in any given year, the award will not be issued for that year. This is the most prestigious of the TC perpetual awards.

Congratulations to Don Crawford for winning Driver of the Year for the 2023 racing year.





Identifying features: This trailer was modified from a Caulkins boat trailer to haul small and mid size race cars. Some of the identifying features are dual axles with leaf springs and center mounted walking beam (Rocker type) suspension. The deck is 12 ft. long expanded metal with two hydraulic center mounted tilt cylinders and a manual lift pump mounted on left front of the tongue. The hydraulic surge brake coupler at the front was recently replaced. The rear loading ramps are of similar construction as the deck and hinge down for loading. Both fenders have multiple dents and the whole trailer is due for fresh paint.
