George Brockbank Memorial Trophy

This trophy was first awarded in 1962. This trophy started out as the Most Improved Driver Trophy. In 1975 TC member George Brockbank had a massive heart attack at the wheel of his Datsun Sedan during a race at Seattle International Raceway. George was a late comer to the sport and it was the fulfillment of a life long dream to have

attained his senior license. He built his own car and drove well throughout his Novice program. He was always upbeat and had a broad grin for everyone at the track. George was not a man of great wealth and was blind in one eye, yet he persevered and raised his family, founded his own business and by any measure succeeded in life. His accomplishment and the spirit in which this award is given is to honor the tenacity it took to overcome adversity and become a race driver. He was always so grateful to those that helped him succeed in his goal. The enthusiasm and spirit he brought to the track is still missed today by those that knew him. So, in late 1975 this trophy was renamed to memorialize George Brockbank.

It is awarded to the member beginning the season as a novice who improves the most. In order to qualify the driver must obtain a senior license by end of current season. This trophy was last awarded in 2021.

Russ was running his Lotus Elan and Steve was running a Datsun 510, both in the Vintage group. Kevin was running his American Sedan Firebird in Group 4, with help from Steve Adams as crew. It was a glorious weekend, weather wise, sunny both days with high temps of about 69-70 both days. Track was pretty fast. Russ got wins in both days vintage races in VP1. Similarly, Kevin got wins both days in American Sedan. Steve was running in VP1, and got a 3rd and a 5th in VP1.

TC members Russ Watson, Jon Wilson and Kevin Smith ran in the CSCC Rose City Opener ICSCC races on April 27, 28th. Steve Adams was crew for Kevin once again. Weather was not nearly as nice as two weeks prior. Saturday was off and on rainy, with a high temp of about 52. Sunday was a little warmer, and a little less rainy in the morning, but by the end of the Group 2 race the track was wet. Russ was racing his Elan again in P1, and Jon was out in his 240Z in P2, both in the Nostalgia group. Both took 1st in their classes in all 3 of the Nostalgia races. Kevin got 1st in his class in both group 4 races, but Sunday's race was a difficult one with dry tires on a wet track.
