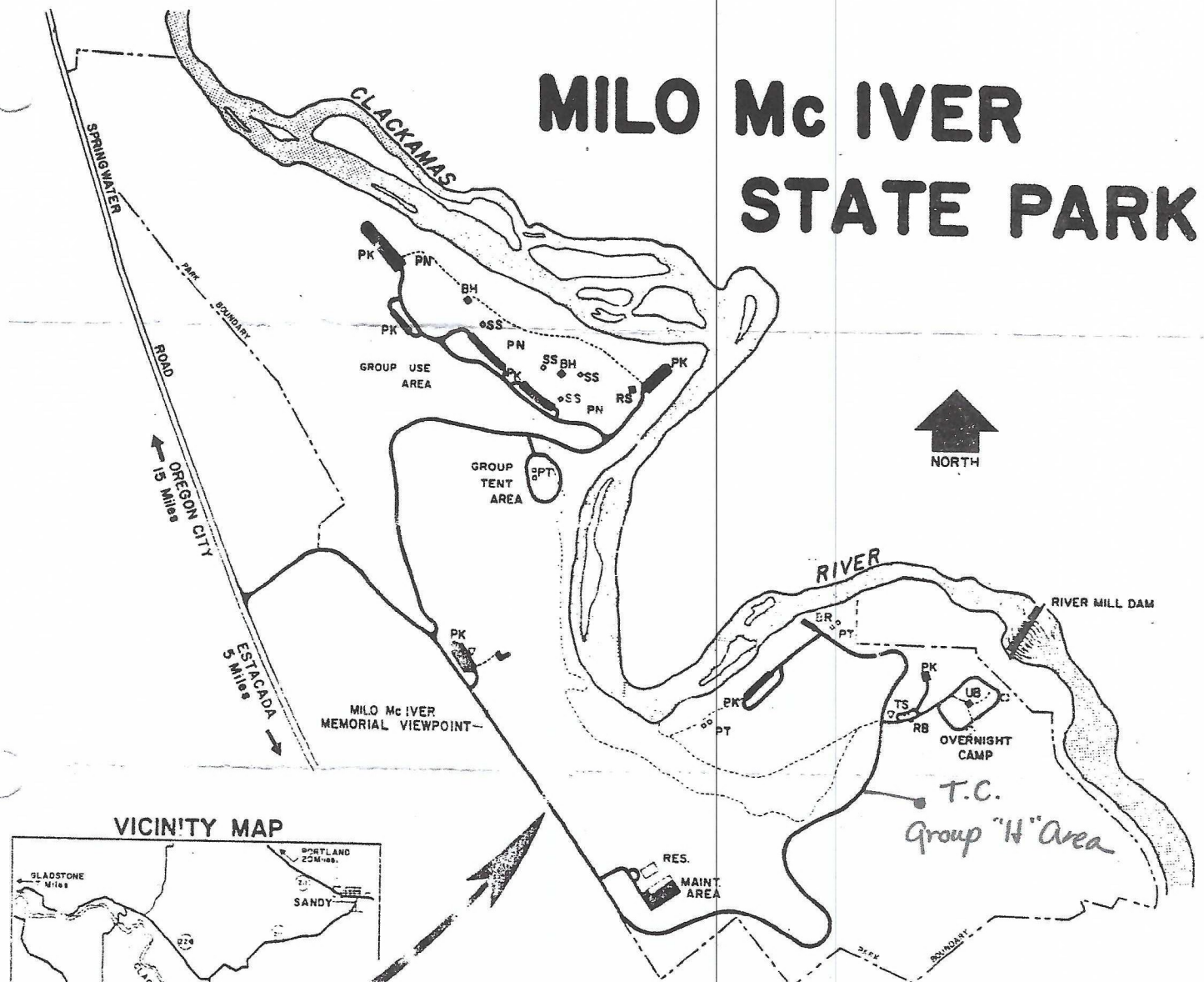
PERSONAL PROPERTY.....TC cannot be responsible for lost or stolen property. Please, folks, let's keep this an honest, no-hard-feeling type of event.

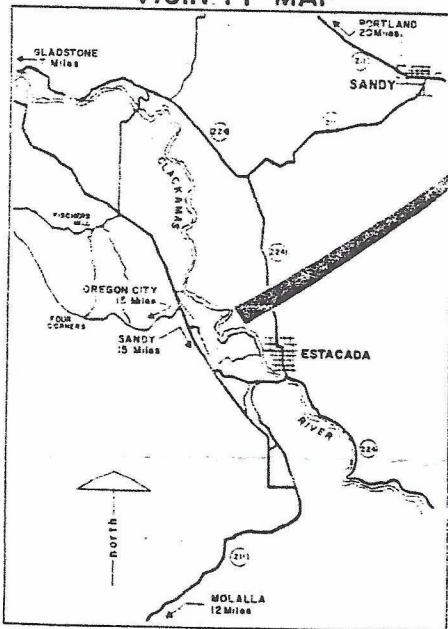
