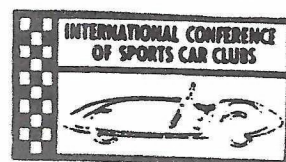

Each car, except formula cars, must have two seats equipped with seat belts in good condition. Stock seat belts are satisfactory.
